




School year 2019-20 was the *transition year* for reporting 5-year-olds in Kindergarten as School Age Children with Disabilities. States/entities had the option to report children who are 5 years old in the reporting categories "Age 5 (School Age)" and "Age 5 (Early Childhood)". The permanent change takes place in SY 2020-21.














Percent of Students Served by Disability Category 10 Year Trend ~ 2010-2019






